Dr. McDougal is Professor and Director of Toxicology Research in the Department of Pharmacology and Toxicology at Wright State University's Boonshoft School of Medicine. Jim earned his degree in Pharmacology/ Toxicology at the University of Arizona about 25 years ago and worked in the Air Force toxicology research organization (various names) for about 17 years.

He has active skin research programs related to dermal pharmacokinetics, molecular biology of skin irritation, dermal risk assessment and biologically-based mathematical modeling.
