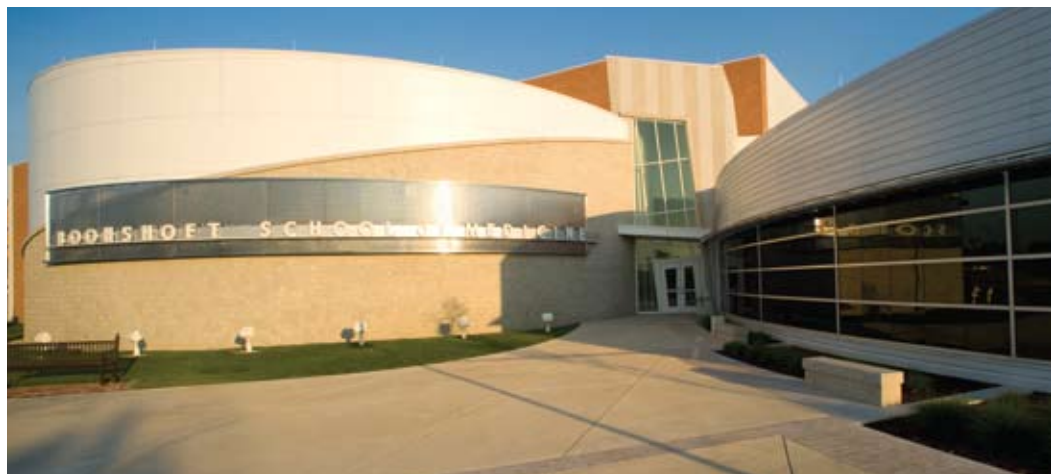

A special public event on September 12 marked the beginning of a new era for the Boonshoft School of Medicine.
